

The Commonwealth of Mlassachusetts AN INITIATIVE PETITION FOR A LAW

Under Article XLVIII of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth

SUMMARY

This proposed law would establish new requirements for corporations to reduce consumer exposure to wireless and electrical radiation emitted by technology.

The proposed law would require technology companies that design, manufacture, install, or maintain digital, internet or wireless infrastructure, technology, or services, to make design and technology choices that reduce consumer exposure to electromagnetic radiation. These companies would be required to limit consumer exposure to wireless radiation from personal devices, personal computers, and other technologies, by requiring that these products meet certain design requirements, such as having the ability to limit the number of wireless transmissions, greater functionality in offline, non-wireless, or airplane modes, and increased non-wireless options.

FILING DEADLINES. Initiative petitions must be submitted to local election officials for certification of signatures no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 20, 2024. Local election officials must complete their certification no later than December 2, 2024. Thereafter, initiative petitions containing certified signatures must be retrieved by petitioners from the local election officials and then filed with the Elections Division, Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, One Ashburton Place, Room 1705, Boston, MA, no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, December 4, 2024.

These companies would also be required to design their infrastructure, technology, or services to limit electrical radiation frequencies by using appropriate connectors and good electrical design.

These requirements would apply to new products, services, installations, and infrastructure and, where compatible, to service and product upgrades and software updates. These requirements must be implemented immediately, within two years, or within four years, as further specified in the proposed law.

The proposed law directs the Attorney General to enforce compliance and creates a private right of action.

The proposed law states that, if any of its parts were declared invalid, the other parts would stay in effect.
